### **FLOWER BED MAINTENANCE**

Although you should be keeping your flower beds looking nice year round, Fall is the perfect time of year to spend extended periods tidying up those flower beds.

### Here is what the HOA is expecting:

- Flower beds free of weeds and grass.
- Bushes cut back and neatly trimmed. The front windows of your home should remain visible.
- Trees should be pruned and tree trunks should be visible; free of suckers.

The branches sprouting from the tree base are called trunk suckers or basal suckers and are best removed so they don't form a bushlike structure around the tree. For practicality and attractiveness, please remember to cut off those suckers!

- Free pine straw, mulch, rocks put down.
- Everything bagged and placed at the curb on Tuesday for trash pick up.

**Remember**- if you're wanting to change items out, you'll need pre-approval through the Architectural Review Committee (ARC).

## **SIGNAGE REGULATIONS**

You may not be aware but our Recorded Covenants do not permit for signage. That being said, our current HOA Board will allow certain signs to remain for a 2-week period.

-Celebratory signs such as those above are permitted. The signs should be placed in your front flower beds, or as close to the front of your home as possible.

-Advertising, political, or religious signage, such as the those below, are **not** permitted.
